

CERTIFIED LIST.

List of persons from Chatham called into the service of the United States not exempted or discharged, as certified by the Chatham Board to the District Board. 200 more men may be called next for examination.

Chatham county's quota for the first draft is 191 men, and of this number 30 per cent will have to report for service during the first week in September. The date for the next 30 per cent is Sept 19th, the third 30 per cent Oct. 3rd, and the remaining 10 per cent as soon thereafter as possible.

The Chatham Board of Exemption Tuesday certified the names of 75 men to the District Board and these men are now therefore duly and legally called for the military service of the United States. They are the same as under orders right now and are merely allowed to remain at their homes in order that they may arrange their affairs. The Board today sent notices to the 75 men, notifying them that they are called and have not been exempted or discharged and further notifying them to hold themselves in readiness to report at Pittsboro on 24 hours notice. THE GRIT will next week publish the names of the remainder as certified to the District Board.

It now seems likely that the Board will be unable to get Chatham's quota out of the 534 men already called, and that an additional call for about 200 more men may be made the first of next week for examination. If so, we will duly publish such names in next issue.
