

Chatham County 1771-1971 is the most comprehensive history of the county available. *The Architectural Heritage of Chatham County* is a beautiful publication celebrating Chatham's historic architectural heritage. *Tales Beyond Fried Rabbit* is an entertaining way to learn Chatham County history.

The Ramsey Map, a reproduction of the original 1870 map by Capt. Nathan A. Ramsey shows rivers, bridges, mills, churches, roads and railroads, and many family locations. *Lucy Worth Jackson's Coal Fields of Chatham*, is a colorful 1874 map with an interesting history. We have a limited number of framed maps available for sale in the Gift Shop.
