

Chatham County Historical Association Donates Materials to Chatham County Schools

Fourth- and eighth-graders will have greater access to local Chatham history. CCHA has provided notebooks of compiled *Chatham Historical Journals* to the media centers in thirteen elementary and middle schools. The *Journals*, published by CCHA from 1988 to 2008, cover a wide range of historical topics—from silkworms to mills, champion cotton pickers to vanished towns, recipes to veterans, letters and memoirs.
