

# First Owners of Pittsboro Lots ~ 1786 to 1793

Ray Carney has created this 1786-1793 map of the layout of lots on the original Town of Pittsborough (original spelling) plat. There were 125 building lots, most of which were half-acre lots with four quarter-acre lots on the courthouse square. Listed in the lot rectangles are the names of people who purchased lots. Ray and his wife, Janet are restoring and living in the Patrick St. Lawrence House (now located on Small Street--it's fourth location in Pittsboro). Their main goal in this lot research was to identify land purchased by a Patrick St. Lawrence, one of the first Town of Commissioners. They researched up until about 1798.
